IX. Closed Meeting

If, during the course of the meeting, discussion of any item on the agenda should be held in a closed meeting, the Board will conduct a closed meeting in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, Government Code:

§551.071: private consultation with school attorney.

§551.072: to deliberate the purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property if deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the Board's position in negotiations with a third person.

§551.073: deliberate a negotiated contract for a prospective gift or donation to the District if deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the Board's position in negotiations with a third person.

§551.074: deliberate the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a public officer or employee or to hear a complaint or charge against an officer or employee.

§551.075: to deliberate in a case in which a complaint or charge is brought against a District employee by another employee and the complaint or charge directly results in the need for a hearing.

§551.076: to deliberate the deployment, or specific occasions for implementation, of security personnel or devices; or a security audit.

§551.082: to deliberate in a case involving discipline of a public school child; deliberate a matter regarding a student if personally identifiable information about the student will necessarily be revealed by the deliberation.

Before any closed meeting is convened, the presiding officer will publicly identify the section or sections of the Act authorizing the closed meeting. All final votes, action, or decisions will be taken in open meeting. [See BEC (LEGAL)].
